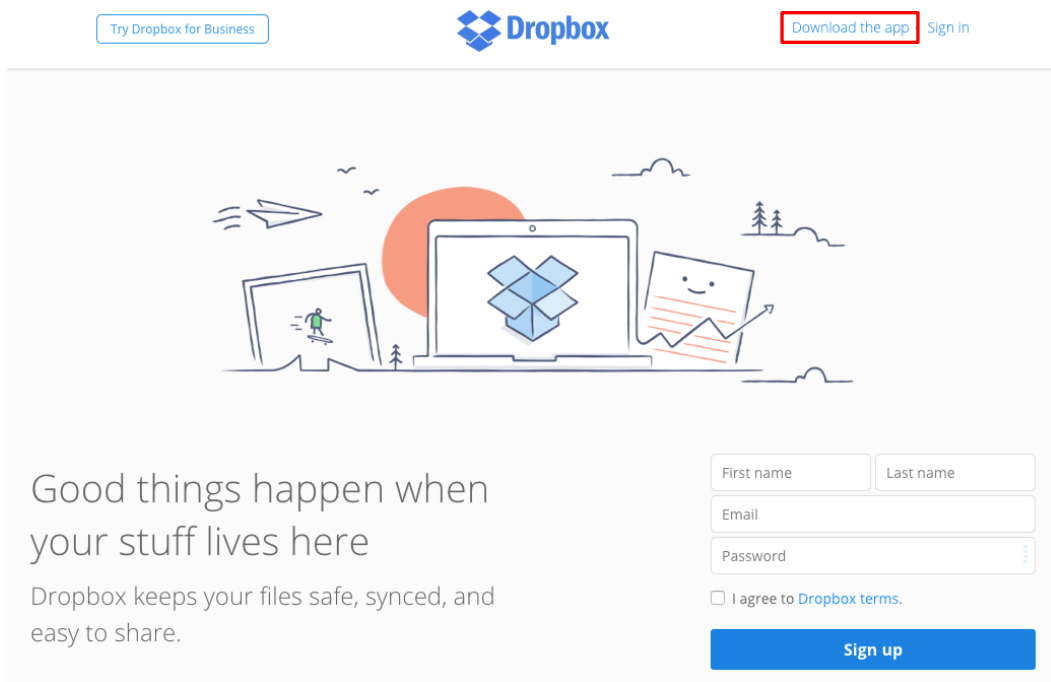


Installing Dropbox onto a Mac OSx Computer

1 Download and open installer

Open your preferred web browser (e.g. Safari, Firefox, Google Chrome, etc.) and navigate to www.dropbox.com.

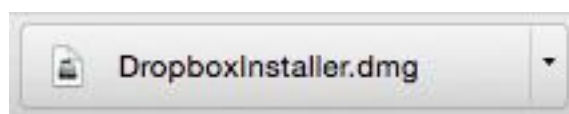
When the page has loaded select the “Download the app” link in the top right corner of the window.

This will take you to the download page. The Dropbox installer should automatically download, if not follow the on screen instructions.

Once the download has finished open the installer from within your browser.

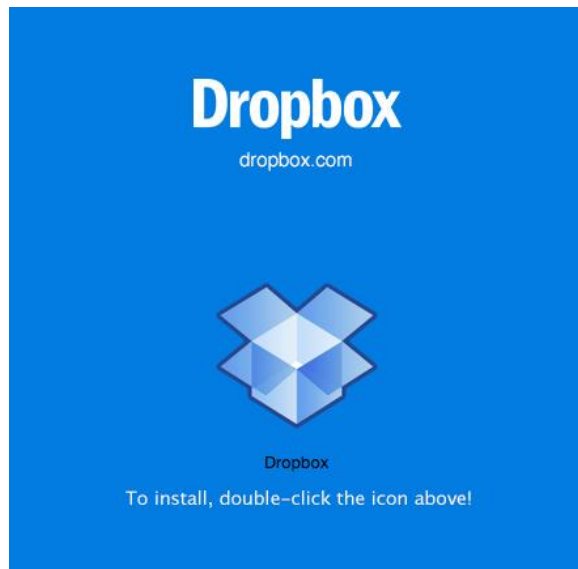


As it will appear in Google Chrome

2 Run Installer and Log in to Dropbox

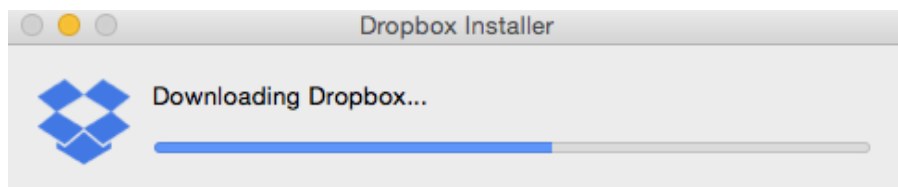
By opening the .dmg file a window will open that will give you the option of installing DropBox.

Double click on the box icon as instructed and the installation will start automatically.



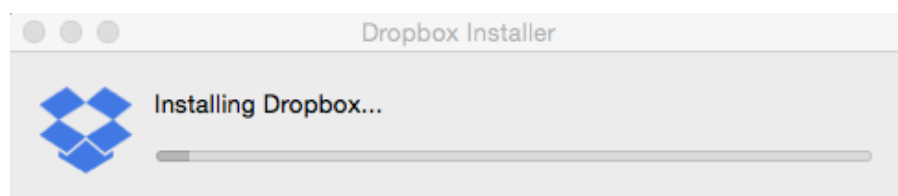
DropBox Installer Window

If asked whether you are sure you would like to open it, select "Open". You should see a window marked "Downloading DropBox"



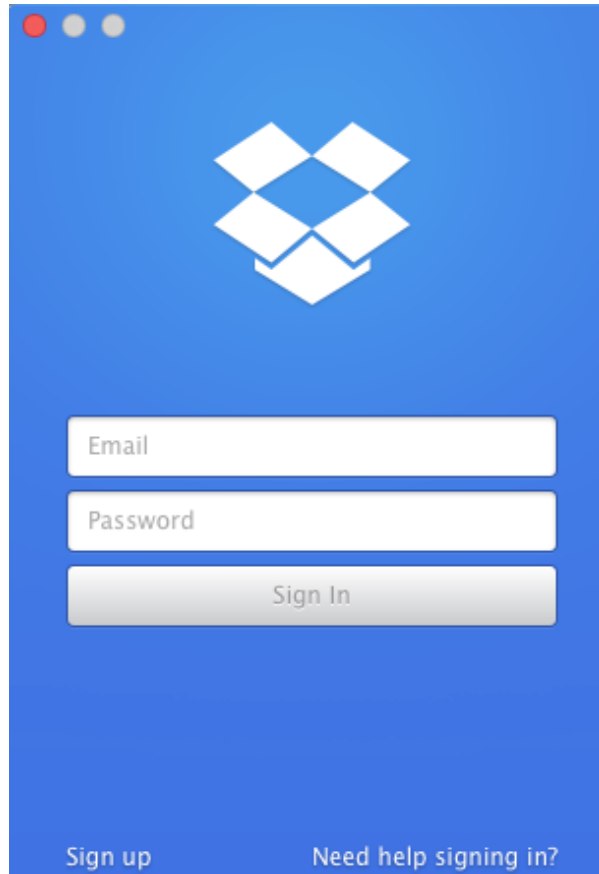
DropBox downloading window

Let the download run until it has finished. At this point the Installer will start to install Dropbox onto your computer.

Once the installation has finished Dropbox will ask you to enter your login details. These are the email address and password that you have registered with Dropbox.

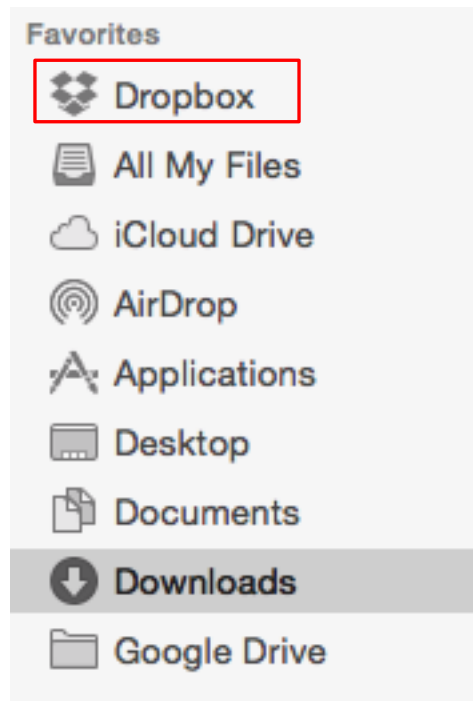


DropBox sign in window

Enter your details and select “Sign In”.

3 Use Dropbox

You have now installed and logged into Dropbox and it is available to use from your computer. Dropbox will now appear as a folder on your computer.



The DropBox folder as seen under favourites in Finder.

Any files that you have on Dropbox will be downloaded onto your computer. Any files that you wish to upload to your Dropbox folder can simply be copied or saved into this folder and Dropbox will sync them with their online folders.
